Dear Parents

Please find below the class and staffing arrangements for September 2024.

Classes generally move from Yellow to Yellow and Green to Green but some years may need to be swapped for a variety of reasons. This year Reception, Year 1 and Year 4 will be swapping colours.

There are a number of staff changes which I have been working with over the last few months.

Three teachers are leaving the school at the end of this term: Mr Rose is moving to China, Miss Galvin to Dubai and Miss Dalton back home. Mr Rose has only been with us for a year, although we knew him as a past pupil. Whilst teaching in Year 6 he has also led the Computing curriculum and his technological expertise will be missed along with his cheery disposition. Miss Galvin has been with us since 2019 and taught in Year 2, Year 1 and more recently in Reception. She has been a wonderfully nurturing teacher and will be sorely missed. Miss Dalton completed her training with us and then was appointed three years ago. In addition to teaching in Year 2 she has led PE for the last year and her enthusiasm for all things sport and dance will be hugely missed.

Ms Oti is expecting a baby and will not be teaching in September (but we will see her on the gate as her eldest joins Reception class!). Mrs Koumpi is also on maternity leave and we hope to see her return at some point next year. Mrs Dinnage is returning from maternity leave next week but will not be working on Mondays. Mrs Weston will be joining her to form a new job share.

I am delighted that we have been able to recruit four new teachers onto the staff to start in September. They will be here on 15th July to meet their new classes. Mrs Khan who has been covering this year on a supply basis, Miss Georgiou who is currently teaching at another Catholic school, Mrs Orphanides who has been busy meeting our Reception parents over the last few weeks and Miss Allen who has recently completed her training. We welcome them all warmly to St Monica's.

Teachers legally are required to have planning, preparation and assessment (PPA) time for 10% of each week.5% of this is covered by Mr Charles-Nelson for Music lessons. Mrs Tottle-Nugent and Mrs Kells will be providing the other 5%.

Many schools are losing their teaching assistant team due to budgetary pressures, however, we are fortunate to have been able to continue to provide this essential support for our children. We have a number of teaching assistants who work part-time and so you may see two or even three names next to some classes. We have allocated staff according to the needs of the children.

Although I must admit, I am looking forward to the summer holiday, I am also looking forward to September. We will very much miss the staff who are leaving us, but look forward to working alongside some new members of staff.
