How can you help at home?

It is essential that the children learn their times tables daily as they will be completing the statutory Multiplication Tables Check this year. The children are required to recall, with speed, all of their times tables from 2-12. You can help at home by ensuring the children are accessing Times Tables Rock Stars daily. You could also display any repeated errors they are making on your fridge so improvements can be made. The children need to know the related division facts of these times tables. E.g. $7 \times 6 = 42$, $42 \div 7 = 6$.

Please listen to your child read every day for ten minutes. Discuss the book with them, the meaning of tricky words and, characters and settings.

In RE this half term...

Our topic is called 'Creation and Covenant' and we will be learning:

In English...

We will be reading a picture book called 'The Green Ship' by Quentin Blake. The children will be exploring the main characters, settings and events in the story. The children will then be writing their own narrative

Some key skills the children will be learning during this topic include:

- writing in paragraphs
- using commas after fronted adverbials
- use inverted commas and other punctuation to indicate speech
- choosing appropriate adjectives

Our topic is called 'States of matter':

exploring solids, liquids and gases We will be:

- looking at how some materials can
- change states between a solid, liquid exploring the concepts of melting and
- learning about The Water Cycle freezing

In PE...

Our topics are called:

- Net and Wall Games: Applying tactics
- Dance: Retelling a story (The Willow Plate)

In history...

Our topic is 'The Roman Republic'. We will learn about:

- the legend of Romulus and Remus
- how Rome became a Republic, led by consuls
- how the Roman Empire began to expand and control islands in the Mediterranean Sea
- battles between Rome and Carthage

In geography...

Our topic is called 'The Rhine and the Mediterranean'. The children will be building upon their knowledge gained in Year 3 about 'Rivers'. In this unit, we will:

- identify the source and the mouth of the River Rhine
- explore how the River Rhine changes during its course
- understand how cities built along the Rhine are affected by the river
- explore how ships sail through the Suez Canal to the Mediterranean Sea

In RHE...

Children will hear and experience the Gospel story of Jesus healing Jairus' daughter. They will learn that they are created by God out of love and for love: they were designed for this purpose, which should inform how they live.

In maths...


Place Value

The children will:

- learn about the place value of numbers with up to 4-
- order and compare numbers to 1,000 and beyond
- round numbers to the nearest 10, 100 and 1,000
- count in 1,000s finding 1,000 more or less than a given number
- read and write Roman numerals to 100
