How to help at home

Continue to encourage your child to read at home, both books from school and books, magazines, and news of their choice. Engage your child in conversation about what they are reading and their thoughts on the text. One of the things we do in Year 6 is to ask the children to use point, evidence, explanation verbally to ensure they can evidence their points and then explain them clearly and coherently. This prepares them for the types of questions they will answer in their SATs.

In class, we have been discussing the importance of healthy habits and sleep. The children really need to support their well-being by getting enough sleep, and looking after their hygiene. This is also

In English...

Our class book is 'Rose Blanche' by Ian McEwan. This is an exceptionally moving picture book in which the reader views the sorrow of war through a young girl's eyes. Rose Blanche discovers a concentration camp full of children in the forest near her home town and silently takes food to them for the remainder of the war. Heartbreakingly, there is no happy ending for Rose Blanche.

The children will be working on different writing styles including newspaper reports, nonchronological reports and letter writing.

As always, the children will continue their regular reading and grammar lessons to prepare them for their KS2 SATs

In Science...


Children will be beginning their work on Electricity. They will explore symbols and diagrams of circuits and build their own circuit using different components.

PE...

Children will be having both indoor and outdoor PE again this half term, and will still be completing their daily mile on the days that we do not have PE. For indoor PE, the children will be working on dance through visual media. In outdoor PE, the children will be working on the skill of attacking and defending in invasion games

In Design and Technology...

This half term, the children will be taking part in some cookery classes. They will be learning easy ways to cook healthy snacks at home. 6G will take part for three weeks consecutively, and then 6Y will have their three weeks of lessons.



French...

In French this half term, the children will be continuing their learning focusing on 'at the weekend'.

Music...

In Music this half term, the children are exploring classical music and learning to play a variety of different melodies on tuned percussion.

In RHE...

Children will continue to learn about:

- Religious understanding
- Personal relationships
- Keeping safe

In Maths...

We will be learning about:

- Ratio
- Decimals
- Fractions, decimals and percentages
- Area, perimeter and volume
- Statistics (data handling)
- Some elements of algebra

(This will be covered over the whole of the spring term,

As always, the children will be learning both arithmetic and reasoning skills throughout the lessons that we teach in order to prepare them for their KS2 SATs and their learning at secondary school.

In Geography...

The children will be building on their previous history learning about Ethiopia, and learning more about its Geography. They will explore how diverse it is, what it is like to live there as well as exploring climate change in Ethiopia.

In ICT...

The children will be introduced to Python in order to programme an animation. They will be using Micro:bit.
